

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FOOTPATH 32, SHAFTESBURY

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All pedestrians will be prohibited from proceeding along the footpath between the A350 and Kingsettle Wood for a distance of approximately 200 metres. The notice is needed to comply with Health and Safety Regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to Highway Users. It will come into operation on 5th April 2021 and will remain in force for six months. However it is anticipated that the closure will be extended, with the approval of the Secretary of State, whilst the construction site is active.

This Notice will enable contractors to construct a housing estate.

Alternative routes will be signposted, as indicated by the blue line on the map below.
